

**Thou Shalt Not Murder**  
**Exodus 20:13; 1 John 3:9-18**  
**January 30, 2022**

There is almost universal agreement, even among \_\_\_\_\_-Christians, that this command should be observed. Few consider themselves \_\_\_\_\_ of committing this terrible sin.
