  - b. Bear – Medo-Persian empire (\_\_\_\_\_, general of Cyrus)
  - c. Leopard – Empire of \_\_\_\_\_ (four wings and four heads, indicating \_\_\_\_\_ in conquest and divided into 4 parts after Alexander the Great's death)
  - d. Dreadful and strong – \_\_\_\_\_ empire, and the ten kings of the revived Roman empire
2. Daniel's \_\_\_\_\_ was the eleventh horn
